- Roedd y Cyngor Sir wedi cytuno cyllido gosod mesurydd clyfar o'r gronfa ganolog a fyddai'n unioni'r defnydd o drydan rhwng y Pwll a'r Ysgol Gyfun
- Gofynwyd i'r Ysgol Gyfun gyfrannu £6,000 yn ystod y flwyddyn ariannol cyfredol er mwyn cwrdd â'r anghydbwysedd yn y cyllido o'r cyflenwad trydan
- Llwyddwyd i gael £11,000 ychwanegol yn grant blynyddol y Cyngor Sir gan ddechrau yn y flwyddyn ariannol ddilynol.

#### 432 Matters Arising from the Minutes

##### **Aberaeron and District Swimming Pool**

Councillor Elizabeth Evans updated Members on the current situation which included the following developments:

- The County Council had agreed to finance the installation of a new smart meter from central funds which would regularise the recording of electricity usage between the Pool and the Comprehensive School
- The Comprehensive School was being requested to contribute a sum of £6,000 during the current financial year in order to meet the current imbalance in the financing of the electricity supply
- An additional £11,000 had been secured in the County Council annual grant, commencing in the next financial year.

**435 Report of County Councillor Elizabeth Evans in respect of the Llanddewi Aberarth Ward**

The following matters were reported by Councillor Evans:

- a) pot-holes were still being reported
- b) information had been received that the extension to the Aberaeron Primary School was included in the County Council capital programme to be undertaken within the next four years.

**436 Report of County Councillor Keith Henson in respect of the Llanbadarn Trefeglwys Ward**

The following matters were reported by Councillor Henson:

- a) The Thriving Communities Overview and Scrutiny Committee had recommended that public utilities plan ahead for undertaking road works and use emergency powers only where and when required
- b) pot-holes were still being reported and were being dealt with in accordance with priorities
- c) following the receipt of information about the faulty street light at

Councillor Sheila Webster: the condition of the road past Penlon needed resurfacing; the ditches on the length of road between Cross Inn and the fingerposts needed attention.
